

Kidderminster Eliminator – Local Information

Getting there and Parking

Go to <http://www.kpctm.co.uk/st-marys-kidderminster/directions> for a map and directions. We have arranged free parking in the large car park on the right at the end of Churchfields, just before the church. GPS co-ordinates DY10 2JX should take you straight to it.

Catering

Food and drinks will be served in the Chantry adjoining the church. Tea, coffee, fruit juice and squash will be served all day. In addition the following will be available.

9.30 - 11.00 Bacon bap, bacon and sausage bap, sausage in a roll, veggie sausage in a roll.

12.00 - 14.00 Jacket potato and salad with various fillings, soup and french bread.

15.30 - 16.30 Cake and biscuits.

The Draw

This will take place at 11.00 in the church.

Pubs etc

The Penny Black (Wetherspoon), in the town centre, will probably be the designated pub again, but check the final handout or ask on the day. There are also two real ale pubs, the Red Man in Blackwell St and the Severn Stars in Oxford St (quite small). For steam railway enthusiasts and also those with children there is the King and Castle at the SVR but note that this is further away and you would have to drive.

The Church and Local Area

St Mary's is a lovely church and a grade 1 listed building. The tow path alongside the canal below St Mary's provides a pleasant walk where you can hear the bells very clearly.

For those with children there is a local park with a nice children's play area, alongside Radford Avenue. You can walk over or drive and park in the street. Unfortunately there are no toilets. Ask a helper if you need directions.
