### 1. London Wall road closure

A road closure has been agreed with the City of London over the following dates from **8am to 8pm**

- **15<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> Feb**
- **8<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> March**
- **22<sup>nd</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> March**
- **5<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> April**
- **18<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> April**

This is to allow for investigation and preparation works for the removal of Bassishaw Bridge which will be carried out from the 18<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> April.

The road closure will remain in place overnight however works will suspend each day. Details of the working hours will be issued nearer the time.

A traffic management plan will be put in place and diversion routes will be clearly signed causing minimal disruption to traffic and pedestrians.
