Facilities:

Toilets are located within the Cathedral.

PLEASE NOTE:

- The toilets located at the bottom of the Addleshaw tower will not be available for use on the day – please wee before you go across.
- Chester Cathedral is a smoke free site. If you wish to smoke, please move off site and away from the main entrance.
- Alcohol bought at the bar must not be taken outside the grounds of the Cathedral.

Travel

- Train: Chester is well connected to the UK rail network. The Cathedral is a 15-20-minute walk from the railway station.
- Car: There is NO on-site parking.

We recommend you use the Park and Ride services.
