

# **12 Bell Eliminator**

## **St Stephen's Church, Bristol**

### **Getting to the Church**

Bristol is easiest accessed by train at Bristol Temple Meads. Don't get off at Bristol Parkway unless you want an extremely long walk. [St Stephen's Church](#) is 15-20 minutes away from Bristol Temple Meads.

There is no parking at the church, and Bristol centre is a low emission zone (you'll be fined if your car is not clean air compliant and do not pay: <https://www.gov.uk/clean-air-zones>). There are plenty of car parks around and about.

### **Catering**

Bristol has a rich variety of pubs, cafes and places to eat. St Stephen's itself has a small café attached (with toilets), but is not reserved for us on the day and is a popular venue.

For pubs, we'd recommend:

- The [Bank Tavern](#) (good beer, lunch served 12-4)
- The [Christmas Steps](#) (good beer, can get busy at lunchtime)
- the [Old Fish Market](#) (towards the river, good beer and traditional pub grub)
- [O'Neils](#) - (almost on the doorstep of St Stephen's serving food and drink)

There are plenty of other good pubs across the city.

There is normally street food on Corn Street, the [Harborside Street Food Market](#), and [St Nicks market](#) has a great mix of food.

### **Toilets**

There are toilets in St Stephen's café, although to respect their customers, we'd recommend using toilets within local pubs (if you're eating or drinking there).
