Hospitality

Refreshments will be served in the Minster throughout the day.

Bacon sandwiches will be available on arrival from 9.30 onwards, and hot food at lunchtime.

Tea, coffee, soft drinks and cakes will be available throughout the day, and a bar serving local beers will open after the draw and continue serving until the results are announced.

Access and toilets.

Level access is available to the Minster through the main south door. There are toilets in the Minster, but please speak to an Event Steward if you will need an accessible toilet.

There are also toilets at the entrance to the tower, but these will only be available to teams as they are entering or leaving the tower.

Public toilets are located in All Saints Square on the north side of the Minster.

Travel & Accommodation

There are no mainline rail services directly to Rotherham, however local services are available from Sheffield, Meadowhall and Doncaster.

There is a wide selection of car parks and on-street parking in and around the centre of Rotherham. Parking in council-owned car parks is free on Saturday, but please note that maximum duration times will still apply. There is a newly-opened Travelodge at Forge Island in the centre of Rotherham, within 5 minutes walk of both the Minster and railway station. Other hotels are available in the area.

Things to do

For the non-ringer, options available include a new cinema on Forge Island offering a range of films in the afternoon.

Meadowhall, get there on the tram service that runs from Rotherham Central every 30mins.

St Anne's Leisure centre for swimming

Clifton Park offers pleasant walking along with a reasonably large children's play area.

Visit Clifton Museum or Boston Castle (a shooting lodge) just outside the town centre.
