Access and toilets

There is level access through the west door and further access through the south porch. Toilets are accessible through the vestry hall. They will be closed for a short period if the judges require access during the competition.

Transport

There will be no competitor parking in the churchyard on the day of the competition as this will be reserved for volunteers, judges and those requiring quick/emergency access.

Leicester is served by 3 park and ride car parks:

Enderby by M1 junction 21 - bus PR2

Maynells Gorse on A47 west - bus PR1

Birstall on A6 (north of the City) - bus PR3
All buses drop off on St Nicholas Circle – a 10 minute walk from Church.
Limited meter parking is available in St Margaret's Street. The nearest multi-storey car park is John Lewis on Vaughan Way. There are also multistorey car parks in Highcross and Haymarket shopping centres and a small surface car park at St Margaret's pastures.

Accommodation

There are numerous Travelodges, Premier Inns, a Novotel, a Holiday Inn within walking distance of the church.

The nearest Park Run is Abbey Park – a 10 minute walk from church. Others are available in Victoria Park, Braunstone Park and Watermead Park.

There will be a raffle in aid of Leicester DG Bell Restoration Fund and Leicester Guild 80th anniversary memorabilia will be available.
